WHAT IS THE "HOUSE"?

• The Tennessee State House is the lower chamber of the Tennessee General Assembly. It consists of 99 state representatives who serve two-year terms. They are not subject to term limits. Each representative represented an average of 72,774 residents, as of the 2020 Census. This body holds impeachment power within the Tennessee General Assembly.

WHAT A "REPRESENTATIVE" DOES!

 Alongside the Tennessee State Senate, it forms the legislative branch of the Tennessee state government and works alongside the governor of Tennessee to create laws and establish a state budget. Legislative authority and responsibilities of the Tennessee House of Representatives include passing bills on public policy matters, setting levels for state spending, raising and lowering taxes, and voting to uphold or override gubernatorial vetoes.


GEOGRAPHY OF TNHD 53 BOUNDARIES

Geographically, Tennessee House
 District expands from parts of the
 Southwestern to the Southeastern
 portion of Nashville-Davidson
 County. It is one of six house
 districts of the Davidson County
 delegation in the Tennessee House
 of Representatives.




GEOGRAPHY OF TNHD 53 COUNTY BOUNDARIES

 The house district is comprised of 12 of Davidson County's 35 Council Districts and the fault lines for each voting precinct lies within each council district. It is part of Senate Districts 20 and 21.



GEOGRAPHY OF TNHD 53 ZIP CODES

Within the house district are 7 zip codes that helps to identify the fault lines for council districts. Respective zips codes are: 37013, 37211, 37220



GEOGRAPHY OF TNHD 53 VOTING PRECINCTS BOUNDARIES

- The house district is comprised of 20 voting precincts. The fault lines for each voting precinct are based on the number of eligible voters living within assigned neighborhoods of council districts, determined by the county planning commission. Voting Precincts include:
- **4**(4-1), **8**(8-1), **16**(16-2), **26**(26-3,26-4), **27**(27-1,27-2,27-3,27-4), **30** (30-1,30-3), **31**(31-1,31-2,31-4), **32**(32-1,32-2), **33**(33-2,33-3,33-4,33-5,33-6)
